

## Catalogues

The Göttinger Universitätskatalog (GUK) lists all holdings of Göttingen University, including the BBK. The following URL offers the option to request books to be delivered directly to the BBK:

Please remember to select the desk where you wish to pick up the book. All terminals in the BBK provide the option to have books delivered to the BBK.

If the item you require is unavailable in the GUK, you may place a request for Interlibrary Loan in the Union Catalogue (Verbundkatalog): <https://kxp.k10plus.de/DB>

In the Union Catalogue you may search using Arabic script but so far only a minor part of the data have original script.
